RULES AND PROCEDURES

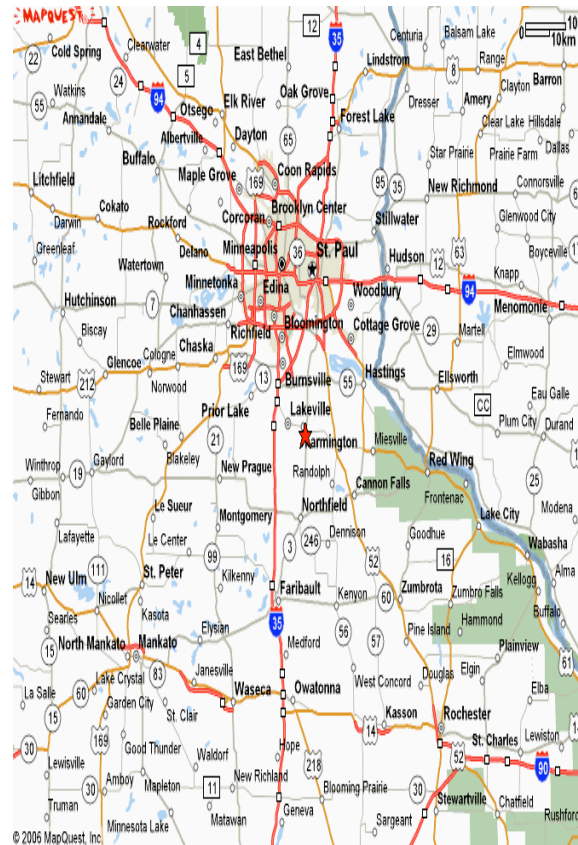
1. The Highland Dance Competition will conform to S.O.B.H.D. rules and standards.
2. In order to receive awards, dancers are required to have a 2010 S.O.B.H.D. registration card *on-site*.
3. Dancers will compete in age groups according to their age on May 22, 2010.
4. The competition committee reserves the right to combine or divide classes depending upon entries received.
5. Dancers entering the competition first will dance last. Fill-ins for reels will be determined as follows: last to enter will be first to fill in.
6. The decision of the judge is final.
7. Communication with the judge or piper regarding the competition, by competitor or other interested parties, is forbidden and may disqualify a competitor.
8. Dancers must be ready and appear when called. Dancers failing to do so will forfeit their chance to dance in that event.
9. Dancers must be in costume to receive awards.
10. Medals and trophies for morning events will be awarded prior to lunch; those for afternoon events will be awarded at the end of the day.
11. Field entries will **not** be accepted.
12. Protests must be made in writing to the competition organizer on the day of the competition, accompanied by a \$25.00 USD Cash fee, which is refunded if the protest is upheld.

All Dancers are encouraged to dance in the mass Highland Fling during the noon-time ceremonies.
